ATIKAL FOUNDATION HOSTS BLOCDV DOMESTIC VIOLENCE BATTERERS REGISTRY CALL TO ACTION WITH GRINAGE FAMILY

BOWIE, MD - On October 11, 2017, the Atikal Foundation will host a BLOC**DV**[™] Call to Action to the DMV regions to reduce lethality from domestic violence occurrences; its impact on unborn children, victims and families; and propel the need for a Domestic Violence Batterers Registry. This is important for public safety to prevent further prevalence of domestic violence occurrences such as Zayla Strange of Falls Church, VA; Andrea Grinage of Capitol Heights, MD; Paula Renee Coles of Southeast, DC; Laura Wallen Howard County School Teacher; and Dasheria Barksdale of Alexandria, VA.

Hosted by the Atikal Foundation, Family of burn victim, Andrea Grinage, and Word of Life Christian Center, one hundred of the metropolitan area's lawmakers, state officials, law enforcement, domestic violence survivors, and frontline professionals, who serve, care for, and minister to victims of domestic violence are expected to attend.
